beginning with an overview of warren's career as a fugitive at vanderbilt and then later as a formidable new critic koppelman argues that warren's regard for the spiritual aesthetic of both literary language and form can be traced to his early study of poetic metaphor to illustrate warren's mature vision koppelman centers his study on two novels and two poetry collections all the king's men a place to come to promises poems 1954 1956 and now and then poems 1976 1978 he also examines the critical studies that concentrate on warren's vision of time history and spiritual fulfillment as well as those essays by warren that complement his poems and novels in such a way as to elicit the reader's participation in the redemption of their narrators

exploring the sexual lives of the poor and working class in turn of the century mexico this social history explores the romantic and sexual lives of the poor and working class in mexico city during the rule of dictator porfirio d az from 1876 to 1911 by analyzing sexually based crime cases and stories in the penny press michael matthews sheds light on everyday struggles joys and desires matthews argues that lower class individuals had more liberated sexual lives than their wealthier counterparts influenced by the city's growth and cultural changes in this book matthews examines how mexico city's expanding infrastructure increasing factory work and new leisure and entertainment activities shaped courtship and sexual practices he delves into the world of tenement buildings and street life to reconstruct days defined by love and desire romance and rape seduction and sex work and promises kept and broken matthews connects the sexual culture of the poor to the changes taking place as the mexican state modernized and underwent tremendous capitalist growth and development sex and love in porfirian mexico city provides insights into how social and economic developments shaped cultural norms surrounding honor marriage morality and parental authority during this period it will spur new reflections on the possible influence of lower class culture on modern day romance and sexual values

i do not consider myself to be robert millikan s biographer this book is not a full record of millikan s life or even of his scientific career it is an essay very selective on themes that are illustrated and illuminated by millikan s life in american science it is as well a portrait of the development of a scientist robert millikan was among the most famous of american scientists to the public of the 1920s millikan represented science the first american born physicist to win the nobel prize millikan was a leader in the application of scientific research to military problems during world war i and a guiding force in the rise of the california institute of technology to a preeminent place in american scientific education and research his life is therefore peculiarly suited to illuminate and provide texture for the vast changes that have taken place in science during the twentieth century in this extended essay i employ the biographical mode to explore several important aspects of this theme millikan was successively a teacher researcher administrator entrepreneur and sage by describing the novel roles that he assumed i suggest how science grew in complexity and carved out an essential place for itself in our general culture robert h kargon from the preface of the rise of robert millikan portrait of a life in american science professor kargon has given us a sympathetic account of millikan s scientific career including his great triumphs his rearguard actions to defend untenable positions and the eventual rejection or revision of every major result or standpoint but he is more concerned with millikan s influence on the developing american physics community and with millikan s role in advancing american science generally and american higher education together with the chemist a p noyes and the astronomer g e hale millikan believed in an american scientific destiny this picture of american science is presented with great insight tremendous learning and wit professor kargon s book strikes a happy balance between being an interpretive story of a scientific life

occupying a space in between conventional scholarship and imaginative storytelling the university in crumbs a register of things seen and heard is an experimental work that dramatizes the everyday life of the academy consisting primarily of a series of five first person reports robert porter kerry ann porter and iain mackenzie provide the reader with a number of stories that attempt to capture some of their everyday experiences of academic life in the uk roughly between 2017 and 2022 self consciously written in a subjective and conversational register and often in dialogical form the university in crumbs is an accessible series of interrelated narratives that allow us to develop a concrete sense of the grain texture and feel for what it might be like to work in the academy at a specific point in time these stories first person reports dialogues come alive acquire their meaning force and pragmatic effect by way of a rather unique circumlocutory form there is a directedness to the everyday talk engaged in by robert kerry ann and iain that nonetheless simultaneously indirectly loops in and out of a kind of technical academic talk that provides the book its light and shade university in crumbs is an experimental work that implicitly and explicitly animates philosophy social cultural and political theory through first person experiences and in so doing breathes new life into what can often otherwise remain rather conventional and technical academic language games more than that this book dramatizes ideas and concepts in ways perhaps less burdened by the weight of canonical tradition and encourages those readers with the talent to portray their social world differently to be more licentious and less bashful in putting such talents to work

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
