travel to an imaginary land to discover the true power of friendship and the heartache of loss provide open ended application and journal prompts to excite students about the reading make a prediction on what the story will be about based solely on the front cover of the novel put events in order that led to the creation of terabithia find the meaning of vocabulary words then use each word in a sentence students describe how they would respond to someone bullying them then students create their own imaginary place like terabithia keep track of events as they happen month by month in the novel with an events calendar graphic organizer aligned to your state standards additional crossword word search comprehension quiz and answer key are also included about the novel a dramatic and fascinating story of friendship jesse aarons is a fourth grader who loves to run once the fastest and best runner at lark creek elementary school in virginia until he was challenged by a girl leslie burke leslie and her parents were new to this community and they soon became best friends their relationship was a strong one then leslie gets a great idea to create terabithia a secret place in the woods only for themselves one day while jesse is not there leslie tries to cross the bridge to terebithia but falls in and drowns when jesse finds out he is devastated soon after the burke family moves away but jesse believes that she has taught him something

get a sense of the remarkable injustices experienced by both horses and the people of the day incorporate well thought out questions that encourage students to really think about their answers determine the setting of the novel based only on a few details from the story prepare for the reading by investigating the purpose of the spur in horseback riding finish sentences from the book with their missing vocabulary words identify joe s error in judgment when tending to black beauty explore ways some of the cruelties experienced by the horses in this novel could have been prevented write a short book review of the novel and post it online choose a major event from the book and complete a concept wheel with details on who what when where and why aligned to your state standards additional

crossword word search comprehension quiz and answer key are also included about the novel nothing could defeat the spirit of this gentle and courageous horse black beauty one of the most endearing stories of all time is set in england during the mid 1800s and is told from the perspective of its main character black beauty shares his adventures from his days as a young colt in the pastures of farmer grey through different owners and into his twilight years tragedy seems to shape the course of black beauty s life as he learns much of the world through the friendships with different horses the tragic life of ginger the brave and noble captain and the fun loving merrylegs

enter a world filled with magic and wonder the worksheets are perfect for small group and individualized work examine the changes happening to mary as she explores the gardens answer multiple choice questions about colin and his mood imagine how mary will spend her time at the manor describe some of the magical elements found in the story elaborate on the theme of mood and health from the book and use it to create a new story explore the idea of positive and negative effects on a character s mood with a helpful graphic organizer aligned to your state standards additional crossword word search comprehension quiz and answer key are also included about the novel the secret garden is a story of the healing magic of nature mary lennox is an unhappy little girl she lives with her parents in india she is left on her own and is waited on by servants when an illness runs through the household mary is suddenly made an orphan she is shipped off to england to live in her uncle s manor there mary must adapt to her new lifestyle she must learn to do things on her own and entertain herself it s in the gardens that mary spends her time the fresh air and natural surroundings seem to do her well as her health and spirits begin to improve the mystery behind the hidden garden only helps to fuel mary s imagination and she is determined to find and unlock its secrets the secret garden is an empowering tale of overcoming one s shortcomings

several stories come together in a climactic battle between a witch a bog monster a dragon and a powerful girl in order to save the villages from an impending volcanic eruption the worksheets are easy to use and not too overwhelming for student comprehension students imagine having luna s magical powers and brainstorm ways they would use it become familiar with unfamiliar words by determining their root word put yourselves into the mind of the villagers to determine why they would continue to sacrifice a child each year identify similes and metaphors used in the chapters draw the map that luna created using detailed descriptions from the chapters identify key vocabulary words from the novel using synonyms antonyms and word associations aligned to your state standards and written to bloom s taxonomy our worksheets incorporate a variety of scaffolding strategies along with additional crossword word search comprehension quiz and answer key about the novel the girl who drank the moon follows the tale of luna who must quickly overcome the obstacles that were hidden from her in order to save the ones she loves in the protectorate village each year the elders sacrifice a newborn baby to the witch who lives in the forest this sacrifice ensures the protectorate s safety for another year what the villagers don t know is that there is no witch at least not an evil one living in the forest not knowing why these babies are left to die the witch xan finds them and takes them to nearby villages to be raised to sustain them on this journey xan feeds the babies starlight one year xan mistakenly feeds the baby moonlight which fills the child with magic xan decides to raise the girl herself in order to keep those around her safe from her magic she names the child luna the story follows luna as she grows and discovers her magic while also coming head to head with the real evil of the forest

comprehension checks students contemplate who would send milo the package containing the tollbooth predict what dictionopolis will be like answer questions with the correct character from the book match idioms found in the story with their meanings complete sentences from the novel with their missing vocabulary words make a list of unpleasant sounds that dr dischord and dynne can collect describe how the dodecahedron felt when milo said numbers aren t important identify all the instances where figurative languages were used in the novel complete a cause effect with some of milo s actions in the story aligned to your state standards additional crossword word search comprehension quiz and answer key are also included about the novel the phantom tollbooth is a story of imagination and wonder milo is a very bored little boy one day he receives a make believe tollbooth when he goes through it he is sent to a magical world there he meets tock the watchdog the pair make their way to dictionopolis one of the country s two capitals here they meet king azaz who sends them on a journey to digitopolis where the mathemagician is holding the two princesses rhyme and reason in the castle in the air on their journey milo and tock meet many different people and places all with their own adventures

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
