this exciting collection of unpublished essays on ernst lubitsch addresses multiple gaps in scholarly and critical engagement with the director his understudied early german films shed light on jewish culture on the relation of comedy to gender and the influence of theatre on his filmmaking the popular historical epics brought lubitsch an invitation to hollywood in 1922 there lubitsch helped develop the film musical and notably contributed to the genre of hollywood romantic comedy the well known scholars film historians archivists and theorists whose essays appear in this volume expand our knowledge of the set designers actors directors and members of the emigré community who contributed to lubitsch s vibrant films an emphasis on the role of material objects opens up a new dimension of critical engagement with the director light is shed on neglected films and the antifascist dimension of his oeuvre brings his political stance clearly to light as these essays make clear lubitsch s cinema is elusive and deserving of our close attention

race music and national identity is the first book length study to examine closely the portrayal of jazz in american fiction during the most critical and dynamic years of the music s development the principal argument suggests that the discourse on jazz was informed largely by a broad range of anxieties endemic to the turbulent decades of the mid twentieth century as the united states faced a new crisis in either foreign or domestic policy writers and intellectuals often used jazz as a forum to change both the public s understanding of the musical tradition as well as the nation s understanding of itself in many ways the rise of jazz from low to high art was a product of this discourse the study relies on a close reading of several notable authors including f scott fitzgerald langston hughes eudora welty ralph ellison and jack kerouac but also responds to a broad range of popular writers from the decade whose contribution to the discourse on jazz has been largely forgotten this book provides an insightful glimpse into how the united states negotiates and ultimately understands its own cultural artifacts paul mccann is an english professor at del mar college

a life at stake is the first serious biography of the legendary russian poet vladimir mayakovsky physically imposing crude a sexual adventurer and ex convict mayakovsky rose to fame between 1912 and 1917 as a futurist agitator and the

author of radical poems and plays he embraced the russian revolution and became one of its most passionate propagandists then at the age of thirty six took his own life disappointed in the course of soviet society and ravaged by private conflicts mayakovsky s poems are as exhilarating today as when he declaimed them for friends in smoky flats in moscow berlin paris and new york in benkt jangfeldt s propulsive biography mayakovsky s life too is compelling a story of constant passionate upheaval against the background of the first world war the russian revolution stalin s terror and cycles of anti semitism mayakovsky emerges from this biography a highly vulnerable figure more a dreamer than a revolutionary more a political romantic than a hardened communist

mediating nature provides a history of the present nature of mass mediation it examines the ways in which a number of discourses technologies and institutions have historically shaped the current ways of imagining nature in the mass media where much of the existing research treats mass mediation as a matter of media technologies texts or institutions this text adopts a somewhat different approach it considers mass mediation as a historical process by means of which the members of audiences and indeed the public more generally came to be incorporated as observers in and of mass culture this approach allows the book to investigate the roles that a wide range of genres relating to nature played in constructing senses of nature but also of mass culture itself the genres include landscape paintings and gardens modern zoos photography early cinema nature essays disaster and animal attack films as well as wildlife documentaries on television the investigation develops what lindahl elliot describes as a social semeiotic approach that combines the semeiotic theory of charles peirce with a historical sociology of cultural formations topical and timely this fascinating book will be of great interest to students and researchers in the fields of media sociology cultural geography and environmental studies

successful future and the man she loves her sister elsa ramstad has everything her heart desires a loving husband a family she adores and a fulfilling life at sea then tragedy strikes now drawing upon her faith and all the strength she can muster elsa must once again discover the woman she is and who she chooses to be four years after her husband s disappearance kaatje janssen struggles to raise two young daughters and tend her farm but when help comes from the most unlikely source kaatje faces both uncertainty about the future and a deep secret from her past and after years of grappling with his feelings for elsa and the mistakes he has made karl is caught in a life of loneliness and emptiness can he finally accept the reality of what he once lost and open himself up to the possibility of what could be separated by physical distance and emotional boundaries these four bound by friendship and family find each other once again and discover that some ties can never be broken in deep harbor midnight sun desperate to know if her missing husband still lives kaatje janssen hires the rugged yet tenderhearted james walker to guide her through the perils of the alaskan wilderness what she finally discovers however is far from what she expected and could well place her in the greatest danger of her life as captain of the majestic and mother of kristian and eve elsa ramstad has sought to ease the ache of her lonely heart but when an old friend rekindles the spark of romance within her will she allow the flames of love to burn again her foolish youth behind her tora anders looks forward to her wedding and a fresh start in life as the wife of her beloved trent storm but first she must confront face to face the terrible demons of her past and her struggle to forgive the man who radically altered her future though widely admired captain karl martensen feels no depth of emotion for any of the women with whom his life becomes uncomfortably entangled he has only tender memories of the love he once lost a love who by the grace of god he may just find again witness the glorious conclusion of the northern lights trilogy as four bound by friendship journey out of the shadow of their darkest days into the bright future awaiting them in the land of the midnight sun

customers in north america copies are available from www.sevenstories.com women s rights have progressed significantly in the last two decades but major challenges remain in order to end global gender discrimination the unfinished revolution voices from the global fight for women s rights outlines the recent history of the battle to secure basic rights for women and girls including in the middle east where the hopes raised by the arab spring are yet to be fulfilled this anthology opens with a foreword by christiane amanpour and features essays by more than 30 writers activists policymakers and human rights experts including nobel laureates shirin ebadi and jody williams most important are contributions from women who have fought against human rights abuses and have become agents of change contributors propose new workable solutions to ongoing rights violations including human trafficking and harmful traditional practices such as child marriage and female genital mutilation as a whole the book shows that the struggle for women s equality is far from over and is essential reading for everyone involved in the fight to realise the full potential for half the world s population
